Section 1395ww(d)(5)(D)(iii). 18 (3) [<del>(2)</del>] is organized and operated as: 19 a migrant, community, or homeless health 20 (A) 21 center under the authority of and in compliance with 42 U.S.C. 22 Section 254b or 254c; or (B) a federally qualified health center under 42 23 U.S.C. Section 1396d(1)(2)(B). 24
