4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 659, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 659.264 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 659.264. VETERANS PERFORMANCE INCENTIVE AWARD. A
8	state agency may make a performance incentive award to a classified
9	employee for providing services to veterans as provided by the Jobs
10	for Veterans Act (Pub. L. No. 107-288), if:
11	(1) the employee has been employed by the agency in the
12	employee's current position for at least six continuous months
13	before the effective date of the award; and
14	(2) the employee's documented job performance and
15	productivity in that position are consistently above that normally
16	expected or required.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
