4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 39.074(a), Education Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	(a) The commissioner may:
8	(1) to ensure compliance with federal law or
9	regulations, direct the agency to conduct on-site investigations at
10	any time <u>with regard</u> to [ <del>answer any questions concerning</del> ] a
11	program, including <u>a</u> special education <u>program</u> , required by federal
12	law or for which the district receives federal funds; and
13	(2) raise or lower the performance rating as a result
14	of the investigation.
15	SECTION 2. Section 382.011, Health and Safety Code, is
16	amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
17	(d) The commission shall consult with the Texas Department
18	of Transportation when determining how to direct available funding
19	resources of each agency to projects and categories of projects to
20	achieve, at the lowest possible cost, the greatest benefits to air
21	quality and to progress toward attainment of national ambient air
22	quality standards in nonattainment areas.
23	SECTION 3. Section 411.0098(b), Government Code, is amended
24	to read as follows:

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(b) Procedures established under this section shall:

2 (1) allow each agency to provide comments and advice 3 to the other agency on an ongoing basis regarding statewide 4 transportation planning efforts that affect traffic law 5 enforcement;

6 (2) define the role of each agency in transportation
7 infrastructure efforts; and

8 (3) require the department and the Texas Department of 9 Transportation to develop a plan for applying for<u>, maximizing</u>, and 10 using federal <u>money</u> [funds] to address infrastructure needs that 11 affect enforcement efforts.

SECTION 4. Section 421.002, Government Code, is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

14 (d) The governor's homeland security strategy must advise 15 local governments of any changes in strategy for grants of federal 16 money for homeland security. The governor may assist a local 17 government in maximizing acquisition or efficient use of federal 18 money.

SECTION 5. Section 751.022, Government Code, is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

21 (d) The office shall undertake efforts to increase the 22 state's share of federal money available for homeland security 23 purposes to more fairly reflect the population of this state.

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SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
