- 16 financial assistance under Chapter 31, Human Resources Code, or an

- 19 (d-1) Subject to Subsection (e), on written request by a
- 20 person appointed as a conservator of a child, the Title IV-D agency
- 21 shall release to that person any information from the agency's
- 22 <u>files</u> and records regarding the home address and place of
- 23 employment of each conservator of the child. This subsection does
