AN ACT

- 2 relating to the designation of a parking space for a person with disabilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 681.009(b) and (c), Transportation 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
 - private property used for parking must designate a parking space or area by conforming to the standards and specifications adopted by the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation under Section 469.052, Government Code [5(i), Article 9102, Revised Statutes], relating to the identification and dimensions of parking spaces for persons with disabilities. [A person who owns or controls private property used for parking may designate a parking space or area without conforming to those standards and specifications, unless required to conform by law.]
- 17 (c) A political subdivision may require a private property
 18 owner or a person who controls property used for parking[+
- [(1)] to designate one or more parking spaces or a parking area for the exclusive use of vehicles transporting persons with disabilities[; or
- [(2) to conform to the standards and specifications
 referred to in Subsection (b) when designating a parking space or
 area for persons with disabilities].

- 3 (f) This [A political subdivision may provide that this]
- 4 section applies to a parking space or area for persons with

- 6 a parking space for persons with disabilities regardless of whether
- 7 the parking space is designated in compliance with the
- 8 identification requirements referred to in Section 681.009(b).
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
