- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 254, Election Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 254.1531 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 254.1531. ANNUAL REPORTING FOR CERTAIN COMMITTEES.
- 8 (a) The campaign treasurer of a general-purpose committee may file
- 9 an annual report under this section if the committee does not intend
- 10 to accept political contributions in a calendar year that in the
- 11 aggregate exceed \$10,000 or to make political expenditures in a
- calendar year that in the aggregate exceed \$10,000.
- 13 (b) To be entitled to file reports under this section, the
- 14 campaign treasurer of a general-purpose committee must file with
- 15 the commission a written declaration of intent not to exceed
- 16 \$10,000 in political contributions or political expenditures in a
- 17 calendar year. The declaration of intent must contain a statement
- 18 that the committee understands that if the \$10,000 maximum for
- 19 contributions and expenditures is exceeded, the committee is
- 20 required to file reports under Sections 254.153 and 254.154.
- 21 (c) A report filed under this section shall be filed not
- 22 later than January 15. The report covers the period beginning
- 23 January 1 of the preceding calendar year, the day the committee's
- 24 campaign treasurer appointment is filed, or the first day after the

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- 1 period covered by the last report required to be filed under this
- 2 subchapter, as applicable, and continuing through December 31.
- 3 (d) If the committee exceeds \$10,000 in political
- 4 contributions or political expenditures before June 30, the
- 5 committee shall file semiannual reports as required by Section
- 6 254.153.
- 7 (e) If the committee exceeds \$10,000 in political
- 8 contributions or political expenditures after June 30, the
- 9 committee shall file a report not later than the later of July 15 or
- 10 48 hours after the maximum is exceeded. A report filed under this
- 11 subsection covers the period beginning the first day of the
- 12 reporting period, as determined under Subsection (c), and
- continuing through the day the maximum is exceeded. The reporting
- 14 period for the next report filed by the committee begins on the day
- 15 after the last day of the period covered by the report filed under
- 16 this subsection.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
