## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to certain temporary wine and beer retailer's permits.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 27.03, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 27.03. DURATION OF PERMIT. (a) Except as provided by
- 7 <u>Subsection (b), a [A]</u> temporary wine and beer retailer's permit may
- 8 be issued for a period of not more than four days.
- 9 (b) A temporary wine and beer retailer's permit issued under
- 10 Section 27.07 may be issued for a period of five days. On notice to
- 11 the commission, the commission may extend the permit for one
- 12 additional day to accommodate the postponement of scheduled racing
- 13 events due to an act of nature.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 27.05(b), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- amended to read as follows:
- 16 (b) The permits shall be issued only for the sale of
- 17 authorized alcoholic beverages at picnics, celebrations, or
- similar events, or events described by Section 27.07.
- 19 SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 27, Alcoholic Beverage
- 20 Code, is amended by adding Section 27.07 to read as follows:
- Sec. 27.07. USE OF PERMIT IN CERTAIN RACING FACILITIES. (a)
- 22 The commission may issue a temporary wine and beer retailer's
- 23 permit to the holder of a mixed beverage permit covering premises
- located in a facility with a seating capacity of more than 150,000

- 1 that is open to the public for use in areas of the facility not
- 2 otherwise covered by a license or permit during a motor vehicle
- 3 racing event sponsored by a professional motor racing association.
- 4 (b) The commission may not issue more than four temporary
- 5 wine and beer retailer's permits under this section in a calendar
- 6 year to a mixed beverage permit holder.
- 7 <u>(c) The holder of a temporary wine and beer retailer's</u>
- 8 permit under this section may not engage in the following
- 9 <u>activities on the areas covered by the permit:</u>
- 10 <u>(1) sell alcoholic beverages in factory-sealed</u>
- 11 containers;
- 12 (2) sell more than two drinks to a single consumer at
- 13 one time;
- 14 (3) sell alcoholic beverages at more than 50 percent
- of the food and beverage concession stands that are open for
- business at any one time; and
- 17 <u>(4)</u> sell alcoholic beverages after:
- 18 (A) 75 percent of the feature race is complete on
- 19 the day that race is held; and
- 20 (B) one hour before the scheduled completion of
- 21 the last spectator event on a day other than the feature race day.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
