4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 27, Alcoholic Beverage
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 27.07 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 27.07. TEMPORARY WINE AND BEER RETAILER'S PERMITS.
7	(a) The commission may issue a temporary wine and beer retailer's
8	permit to the holder of a mixed beverage permit covering premises
9	located in a facility with a seating capacity of more than 150,000
10	that is open to the public for use in areas of the facility not
11	otherwise covered by a license or permit during a motor vehicle
12	racing event sponsored by a national professional stock automobile
13	racing association or a national professional open wheel racing
14	association.
15	(b) The commission may not issue more than three temporary
16	wine and beer retailer's permits under this section in a calendar
17	year to a mixed beverage permit holder.
18	(c) The holder of a temporary wine and beer retailer's
19	permit under this section may not engage in the following
20	activities on the areas covered by the permit:
21	(1) sell alcoholic beverages between 2 a.m. and noon
22	on Sunday;
23	(2) sell alcoholic beverages in factory-sealed
24	containers;

- 1 (3) sell more than two drinks to a single consumer at
- 2 one time;
- 3 (4) sell alcoholic beverages at more than 50 percent
- 4 of the food and beverage concession stands that are open for
- 5 business at any one time; and
- 6 (5) sell alcoholic beverages after 75 percent of the
- 7 <u>last race of the day is complete.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
