- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 341.401(a), Finance Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (a) An authorized lender or other person involved in a
- 7 transaction subject to this title may not deny to an individual who
- 8 has the capacity to contract an extension of credit, including a
- 9 loan, in the individual's name or restrict or limit the credit
- 10 extended:
- 11 (1) because of sex, race, color, religion, national
- 12 origin, marital status, or age;
- 13 (2) because all or part of the individual's income
- 14 derives from a public assistance program in the form of social
- 15 security or supplemental security income; [or]
- 16 (3) because the individual has in good faith exercised
- 17 a right under the Consumer Credit Protection Act (15 U.S.C. Section
- 18 1601 et seq.; 18 U.S.C. Section 891 et seq.); or
- 19 (4) because the individual has been a victim of
- 20 <u>identity theft</u>.
