AN ACT

- 2 relating to providing interpreter services to certain recipients of
 3 medical assistance or their parents or guardians.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 32.024, Human Resources Code, is amended 6 by adding Subsection (bb) to read as follows:
- 7 (bb) In this subsection, "deaf" and "hard of hearing" have 8 the meanings assigned by Section 81.001. The department shall
- 9 provide interpreter services as requested during the receipt of
- 10 medical assistance under this chapter to:
- 11 (1) a person receiving that assistance who is deaf or
 12 hard of hearing; or
- 13 (2) a parent or guardian of a person receiving that
 14 assistance if the parent or guardian is deaf or hard of hearing.
- SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 18 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 19 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 20 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
