A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to requiring approval of certain contracts entered into3 between superintendents and independent school districts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 11.201(b), Education Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

(b) The board of trustees of an independent school district
may employ by contract a superintendent for a term not to exceed
five years. <u>A contract to employ a superintendent that provides for</u>
<u>an annual salary increase of 20 percent or more must be approved by</u>
the Teacher Retirement System of Texas.

12 SECTION 2. Section 11.201(b), Education Code, as amended by 13 this Act, applies only to a contract entered into between the board 14 of trustees of an independent school district and a superintendent on or after the effective date of this Act. A contract entered into 15 between the board of trustees of an independent school district and 16 a superintendent before the effective date of this Act is governed 17 by the law in effect at the time the contract was entered into, and 18 that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 19

20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
