| 5  | SECTION 1. Chapter 1, Title 28, Revised Statutes, is                 |
| 6  | amended by adding Article to read as follows:                        |
| 7  | Art MUNICIPAL VALIDATION FOR TOWN OF SOUTH PADRE                     |
| 8  | ISLAND. Sec. 1. An annexation or attempted annexation by the Town    |
| 9  | of South Padre Island that occurred after May 1, 2004 and before     |
| 10 | January 1, 2005 is validated as of the date it occurred.             |
| 11 | Sec. 2. This article does not apply to:                              |
| 12 | (1) an annexation or attempted annexation that was                   |
| 13 | void at the time it occurred;  |
| 14 | (2) an annexation or attempted annexation that, under                |
| 15 | a statute of this state, was a misdemeanor or felony at the time the |
| 16 | act or proceeding occurred;  |
| 17 | (3) an incorporation or attempted incorporation of a                 |
| 18 | municipality within the incorporated boundaries or                   |
| 19 | extraterritorial jurisdiction of another municipality that           |
| 20 | occurred without the consent of the other municipality in violation  |
| 21 | of Chapter 42 or 43, Local Government Code;                          |
| 22 | (4) an ordinance that, at the time it was passed, was                |
| 23 | preempted by a statute of this state or the United States, including |
| 24 | Section 1.06 or 109.57, Alcoholic Beverage Code; or                  |

| 2  | article:   |
| 3  | (A) is involved in litigation if the litigation                    |
| 4  | ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final     |
| 5  | judgment of a court; or  |
| 6  | (B) has been held invalid by a final judgment of a                 |
| 7  | <u>court.</u>  |
| 8  | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives        |
| 9  | a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  |
| 10 | provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this   |
| 11 | Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this |

12 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
