## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT relating to the transfer of certain convicted felons from county 2 3 jail to the custody of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 4, Article 42.09, Code of Criminal 5 Procedure, is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 4. If a defendant is convicted of a felony, is eligible 7 for release on bail pending appeal under Article 44.04(b), and 8 gives notice of appeal, he shall be transferred to 9 the Institutional Division of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice 10 11 on a commitment pending a mandate from the Court of Appeals or the 12 Court of Criminal Appeals [upon request in open court or upon 13 written request to the sentencing court. Upon a valid transfer to the institutional division under this section, the defendant may 14 not thereafter be released on bail pending his appeal]. 15 SECTION 2. This Act applies to a defendant on whom a 16 sentence of a term of imprisonment in the institutional division of 17 18 the Texas Department of Criminal Justice is pronounced on or after the effective date of this Act. 19
