1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the duties of the Texas Historical Commission relating
1-9 to El Camino Real de los Tejas National Historic Trail.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Chapter 442, Government Code, is amended by
1-12 adding Section 442.021 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 442.021. EL CAMINO REAL DE LOS TEJAS NATIONAL HISTORIC
1-14 TRAIL. (a) In cooperation with the National Park Service, the
1-15 commission shall administer and coordinate the efforts of state and
1-16 local public and private entities in this state regarding the
1-17 preservation of El Camino Real de los Tejas National Historic
1-18 Trail.

1-19 (b) The commission shall develop educational and
1-20 interpretative programs relating to El Camino Real de los Tejas
1-21 National Historic Trail.

1-22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-26 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
