5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 13, Water Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 13.146 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 13.146. CERTAIN PROPOSED RATE INCREASES. (a) This
8	section does not apply to a proposed increase in rates if the
9	increase is necessary to ensure the provision of continuous and
10	adequate services to the customers of a water or sewer utility.
11	(b) A water or sewer utility may not cumulatively increase
12	rates by 25 percent or more in a calendar year unless a majority of
13	the members/customers in the water or sewer utility affected by the
14	proposed rate increase, voting in an election called and held for
15	that purpose, approve the proposed rate increase. A governing body
16	of a water or sewer utility may call the election. The election
17	must be held in accordance with the Election Code.
18	(c) If a majority of the voters in the water or sewer utility
19	affected by the proposed rate increase, voting in the election,
20	approve the proposed rate increase, the water or sewer utility may
21	increase the rates.
22	(d) If a majority of the voters in the water or sewer utility
23	affected by the proposed rate increase, voting in the election, do
24	not approve the proposed rate increase, the water or sewer utility

- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
