A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the minimum salary schedule for public school 3 employees. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 21.402, subsection (a), Education Code 5 6 is amended as follows: (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), (e), or (f), a school 7 district must pay each classroom teacher, full-time librarian, 8 full-time counselor certified under Subchapter B, educational 9 diagnostician, speech pathologist or full-time school nurse not 10 11 less that the minimum monthly salary, based on the employee's level 12 of experience, determined by the following formula: 13 MS=SF x FS 14 where: 15 "MS" is the minimum monthly salary; "SF" is the applicable salary factor specified by Subsection 16 (c); and 17 "FS" is the amount, as determined by the commissioner under 18 Subsection (b), of state and local funds per weighted student 19 available to a district eligible to receive state assistance under 20 21 Section 42.302 with an enrichment tax rate, as defined by Section 22 42.302, equal to the maximum rate authorized under Section 42.303, except that the amount of state and local funds per weighted student 23 does not include the amount attributable to the increase in the 24

3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

4 SECTION 3. The importance of this legislation and the 5 crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an 6 emergency and an imperative public necessity that the 7 constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several 8 days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended.
