1-7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO. 1 By: Madla

1-8 Amend H.B. 3333 (engrossed version) as follows:

1-9 (1) In the recital to SECTION 1 of the bill (page 1, lines 34  
1-10 and 35, strike "Sections 202.021(b) and (c), Transportation Code,  
1-11 are "and substitute" Section 202.021(b), Transportation Code,  
1-12 is".

1-13 (2) In SECTION 1 of the bill, in amended Subsection (b),  
1-14 Section 202.021, Transportation Code (page 1, line 40), between  
1-15 "landowners" and the comma, insert "of Tract 11, Block 49 of the  
1-16 Ysleta Grant located in El Paso County".

1-17 (3) Strike amended Subsection (c), Section 202.021,  
1-18 Transportation Code (page 1, lines 45-54).

1-19 (4) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTION to the  
1-20 bill and renumber subsequent SECTIONS as appropriate:

1-21 SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Subchapter B, Chapter 202, Transportation  
1-22 Code, is amended by adding Section 202.034 to read as follows:

1-23 Sec. 202.034. SALE OR CONVEYANCE OF BRIDGE. (a) The  
1-24 department shall sell or convey the part of the Presidio  
1-25 International Bridge owned by this state to the City of Presidio and  
1-26 Presidio County.

1-27 (b) A sale or conveyance under this section must comply with  
1-28 all state and federal rules governing the transaction.

1-29 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-30 AN ACT

1-31 relating to the sale or transfer of interest of real property to  
1-32 certain federally recognized Indian tribes.

1-33 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-34 SECTION 1. Sections 202.021(b) and (c), Transportation  
1-35 Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-36 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), real property  
1-37 shall be transferred or sold with the following priorities:

1-38 (1) to a governmental entity with the authority to  
1-39 condemn the property; [~~or~~]

1-40 (2) to abutting or adjoining landowners, including a  
1-41 federally recognized Indian tribe whose reservation is located  
1-42 within counties of this state bordering the Republic of Mexico and  
1-43 that is not subject to the federal Indian Gaming Regulatory Act; or

1-44 (3) to the general public.

1-45 (c) A highway right-of-way shall be transferred or sold with  
1-46 the following priorities:

1-47 (1) to a governmental entity with the authority to  
1-48 condemn the property;

1-49 (2) to abutting or adjoining landowners; [~~or~~]

1-50 (3) to a federally recognized Indian tribe whose  
1-51 reservation is located within counties of this state bordering the  
1-52 Republic of Mexico and that is not subject to the federal Indian  
1-53 Gaming Regulatory Act; or

1-54 (4) to the general public.

1-55 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-56 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-57 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-58 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-59 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
