- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 466, Government Code, is
- 5 amended by adding a new section to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 466.257. Sale of Ticket Through Internet Computer
- 7 Terminal.
- 8 (a) The commission may sell a ticket by use of computer
- 9 terminals, through the internet, or by means of other electronic
- 10 devices that technology may permit.
- 11 (b) The commission shall adopt rules establishing a method
- 12 by which the commission shall sell a ticket by use of computer
- 13 terminals, through the internet, or by means of other electronic
- 14 devices that technology may permit.
- 15 (c) The commission shall create a practical method or system
- 16 by which an individual eligible to purchase a ticket may purchase a
- 17 ticket by use of a private or public computer terminal or other
- 18 electronic means through use of a debit account or by means of an
- 19 account established with the commission or by some other system
- 20 that provides for a practical means for the individual to purchase a
- 21 ticket by use of computer terminals, through the internet, or by
- 22 means of other electronic devices that technology may permit.
- 23 SECTION 2. TRANSITION. No later than January 1, 2006, the
- 24 commission shall create a method or system by which an individual

- 1 eligible to purchase a ticket may purchase a ticket as provided by
- 2 the Act and the commission shall adopt the rules as required under
- 3 this Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 5 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 6 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 7 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 8 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
