- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.022(b), Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality may
- 8 expand beyond the distance limitations imposed by Section 42.021 to
- 9 include an area contiguous to the otherwise existing
- 10 extraterritorial jurisdiction of the municipality if the owners of
- 11 the area request the expansion. A municipality with fewer than
- 12 5,000 inhabitants may not expand its extraterritorial jurisdiction
- 13 under this subsection beyond the extent of the extraterritorial
- jurisdiction of a municipality with 5,000 to 24,999 inhabitants in
- 15 Section 42.021.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to an expansion of extraterritorial jurisdiction for which the
- 18 request in expansion required by Section 42.022(b), Local
- 19 Government Code, is provided to the municipality on or after the
- 20 effective date of this Act. An expansion for which the request is
- 21 provided before that date is governed by the law in effect at the
- 22 time the request is provided, and the former law is continued in
- 23 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
