- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 403, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Sections 403.020, 403.0201, 403.0202, 403.0203,
- 7 and 403.0204 to read as follows:

- 8 Sec. 403.020. EFFICIENCY REVIEW OF STATE AGENCIES. (a) In
- 9 this section, "state agency" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 10 2056.001.

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- 11 (b) The comptroller periodically may review and analyze the
- 12 effectiveness and efficiency of the policies, management, fiscal
- 13 affairs, and operations of state agencies.
- 14 (c) The comptroller shall report the findings of the review
- and analysis to the governor and the legislature.
- 16 (d) The legislature may consider the comptroller's reports
- in connection with the legislative appropriations process.
- 18 Sec. 403.0201. PERFORMANCE REVIEW OF INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER
- 19 EDUCATION. (a) In this section, "public junior college" and
- 20 "general academic teaching institution" have the meanings assigned
- 21 by Section 61.003, Education Code.
- (b) The comptroller may periodically review the
- 23 effectiveness and efficiency of the budgets and operations of:
- 24 (1) public junior colleges; and

1	(2) general academic teaching institutions.							
2	(c) A review under this section may be initiated by the							
3	comptroller or at the request of:							
4	(1) the governor; or							
5	(2) the public junior college or general academic							
6	teaching institution.							
7	(d) A review may be initiated by a public junior college or							
8	general academic teaching institution only at the request of the							
9	president of the college or institution or by a resolution adopted							
10	by a majority of the governing body of the college or institution.							
11	(e) If a review is initiated by a public junior college or							
12	general academic teaching institution, the comptroller may require							
13	the college or institution to pay 25 percent of the cost incurred in							
14	conducting the review.							
15	(f) The comptroller shall:							
16	(1) prepare a report showing the results of each							
17	review conducted under this section;							
18	(2) file the report with:							
19	(A) the chief executive officer of the public							
20	junior college or general academic teaching institution that is the							
21	subject of the report; and							
22	(B) the governor, the lieutenant governor, the							
23	speaker of the house of representatives, the chairs of the standing							
24	committees of the senate and of the house of representatives with							
25	primary jurisdiction over higher education, and the commissioner of							
26	higher education; and							
27	(3) make the entire report and a summary of the report

- 2 Sec. 403.0202. PERFORMANCE REVIEW OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS. (a)
- 3 The comptroller may periodically review the effectiveness and
- 4 efficiency of the operations of school districts, including the
- 5 district's expenditures for its officers' and employees' travel
- 6 services. A review of a school district may be initiated by the
- 7 comptroller at the comptroller's discretion or on the request of
- 8 the school district. A review may be initiated by a school district
- 9 only by resolution adopted by a majority of the members of the board
- of trustees of the district.
- 11 (b) If a review is initiated on the request of the school
- 12 district, the comptroller may require the district to pay 25
- 13 percent of the cost incurred in conducting the review.
- 14 (c) The comptroller shall:
- 15 <u>(1) prepare a report showing the results of each</u>
- 16 <u>review conducted under this section;</u>
- 17 (2) file the report with the school district, the
- 18 governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of
- 19 representatives, the chairs of the standing committees of the
- 20 senate and the house of representatives with jurisdiction over
- 21 public education, and the commissioner of education; and
- 22 (3) make the entire report and a summary of the report
- 23 available to the public on the Internet.
- Sec. 403.0203. REVIEW OF INTERSCHOLASTIC COMPETITION. The
- 25 comptroller may periodically review and analyze the effectiveness
- 26 and efficiency of the policies, management, fiscal affairs, and
- operations of an organization that is a component or part of a state

- 1 agency or institution and that sanctions or conducts
- 2 interscholastic competition. The comptroller shall report the
- 3 findings to the governor and the legislature. The legislature may
- 4 consider the comptroller's reports in connection with the
- 5 <u>legislative appropriations process.</u>
- 6 Sec. 403.0204. RECORDS MANAGEMENT REVIEW. (a) In this
- 7 <u>section</u>, "state agency" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 8 2056.001.
- 9 (b) The comptroller may periodically review and analyze the
- 10 effectiveness and efficiency of the policies and management of a
- 11 state governmental committee or state agency that is involved in:
- 12 (1) analyzing and recommending improvements to the
- 13 state's system of records management; and
- 14 (2) preserving the essential records of this state,
- including records relating to financial management information.
- 16 SECTION 2. Sections 322.015, 322.016, 322.0165, 322.017,
- and 322.018, Government Code, are repealed.
- 18 SECTION 3. On the effective date of this Act:
- 19 (1) all records and other property of the Legislative
- 20 Budget Board that relate to efficiency reviews of state agencies,
- 21 performance reviews of institutions of higher education,
- 22 performance reviews of school districts, reviews of
- 23 interscholastic competition, or records management reviews are
- transferred to the comptroller of public accounts;
- 25 (2) all unexpended and unobligated appropriations of
- 26 the Legislative Budget Board relating to the board's efficiency
- 27 reviews of state agencies, performance reviews of institutions of

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- 1 higher education, performance reviews of school districts, reviews
- of interscholastic competition, or records management reviews are
- 3 transferred to the comptroller of public accounts;
- 4 (3) all employees of the Legislative Budget Board
- 5 whose primary functions relate to efficiency reviews of state
- 6 agencies, performance reviews of institutions of higher education,
- 7 performance reviews of school districts, reviews of
- 8 interscholastic competition, or records management reviews become
- 9 employees of the comptroller of public accounts; and
- 10 (4) any reference in law to the Legislative Budget
- 11 Board that relates to efficiency reviews of state agencies,
- 12 performance reviews of institutions of higher education,
- 13 performance reviews of school districts, reviews of
- 14 interscholastic competition, or records management reviews means
- 15 the comptroller of public accounts.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
