- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 271, Local Government Code 6 is amended by adding Section 271.0462 to read as follows:
- Sec. 271.0462. CHANGE IN USE OF PROCEEDS. The governing

 body of an issuer may change the use of proceeds of outstanding

 certificates for other purposes permitted under this subchapter:

 (a) If the costs of the new project to be financed does not exceed

 percent of the original principal amount of the outstanding

 certificates, the governing body may pass a resolution authorizing

such proceeds to be used for such purpose.

- 14 (b) If the cost of the new project(s) exceed 10 percent of
 15 the original principal amount of the outstanding certificates, the
 16 governing body must publish notice of its intent to adopt a
 17 resolution authorizing the use of proceeds to finance such new
 18 project(s) in the same manner as prescribed in section 271.049 and
 19 if five percent of the qualified voters file a written petition
 20 protesting such proposal, an election shall be held as described in
- 21 <u>section 271.049.</u>
