- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 701.051, Insurance Code, as effective
- 5 April 1, 2005, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 701.051. DUTY TO REPORT. (a) Not later than the 30th
- 7 day after the date the person makes the determination or has
- 8 reasonable grounds for suspicion, a [A] person who determines or
- 9 reasonably suspects that a fraudulent insurance act has been or is
- 10 about to be committed:
- 11  $\underline{\text{(1)}}$  shall report the information in writing to the
- 12 <u>insurance fraud unit of</u> the department, in the format prescribed by
- 13 the fraud unit; and
- 14 (2) may also report the information to another [<del>or an</del>]
- 15 authorized governmental agency [not later than the 30th day after
- 16 the date the person makes the determination].
- (b) A report made to [one authorized governmental agency or]
- 18 the <u>insurance fraud unit</u> [department] constitutes notice to each
- 19 other <u>appropriate</u> authorized governmental agency [and the
- 20 department].
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 701.052(b), Insurance Code, as effective
- 22 April 1, 2005, is amended to read as follows:
- 23 (b) A person may furnish information as described in
- 24 Subsection (a) orally or in writing, including through publishing,

- 1 disseminating, or filing a bulletin or report. A person may furnish
- 2 the information anonymously.
- 3 SECTION 3. Section 701.108, Insurance Code, as effective
- 4 April 1, 2005, is amended to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 701.108. [INSURER'S] DUTY TO PROVIDE INFORMATION. On
- 6 the written request of an authorized governmental agency, an
- 7 insurer, or a person authorized to act on behalf of the insurer,
- 8 shall provide to the agency any relevant information or material
- 9 relating to a matter under investigation.
- SECTION 4. Section 701.109, Insurance Code, as effective
- 11 April 1, 2005, is amended to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 701.109. REQUEST FOR INVESTIGATION BY INSURER. (a)
- 13 An insurer who conducts [must complete] an independent
- investigation of suspected insurance claim fraud is not required to
- 15 <u>complete that investigation</u> [and draft a report of the insurer's
- 16 **findings**] before requesting that the commissioner conduct an
- 17 investigation.
- 18 (b) The insurer shall draft a report of the insurer's
- 19 findings and [must] submit the report and any [the] related
- 20 investigation file to the commissioner <u>as soon as practicable on</u>
- 21 the conclusion [as part] of the insurer's independent [request that
- 22 the commissioner conduct an investigation.
- SECTION 5. Section 701.052(f), Insurance Code, as effective
- 24 April 1, 2005, is repealed.
- 25 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
