- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 101.106, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) The attorney representing the state is not required to
- 8 prove the existence of a culpable mental state in the prosecution of
- 9 an offense under this section.
- 10 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 11 only to the punishment for an offense committed on or after the
- 12 effective date of this Act. For purposes of this section, an
- offense is committed before the effective date of this Act if any
- 14 element of the offense occurs before the effective date.
- 15 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 16 Act is governed by the law in effect on the date that the offense was
- 17 committed, and the former law is continued in effect for this
- 18 purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
