## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a kindergarten-plus program for certain children.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 29.161 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 29.161. KINDERGARTEN-PLUS PROGRAM. (a) In addition
7	to any other funding to which a school district is entitled, from
8	funds appropriated for that purpose, the commissioner shall
9	distribute to each school district an amount of money equal to the
10	product of \$2,000 multiplied by the number of children in average
11	daily attendance, as determined under Section 42.005, in the
12	district's kindergarten-plus program. A district may use funds
13	received under this subsection only for the purpose of the
14	district's kindergarten-plus program.
15	(b) A child is eligible to participate in a school
16	district's kindergarten-plus program if:
17	(1) the child is entitled to attend school in the
18	district under Section 25.001;
19	(2) the child:
20	(A) is enrolled or is planning to enroll in a
21	district kindergarten class for the next school year; or
22	(B) has just completed kindergarten;
23	(3) the child is educationally disadvantaged; and
24	(4) the child's parent or guardian has applied for the

- 1 child to participate in the kindergarten-plus program in the time
- 2 and manner required by the district and the district has accepted
- 3 <u>the child's application.</u>
- 4 (c) A school district kindergarten-plus program must, at a
- 5 minimum, consist of:
- 6 (1) six weeks of additional instruction for an
- 7 eligible child during the summer before the child will begin
- 8 kindergarten; and
- 9 (2) six weeks of additional instruction for an
- 10 eligible child during the summer after the child completes
- 11 <u>kindergarten.</u>
- 12 (d) In addition to compensation from funds provided under
- 13 this section, a teacher who teaches for a kindergarten-plus program
- 14 is entitled to two additional professional development days each
- 15 school year.
- 16 (e) The commissioner shall adopt rules necessary to
- 17 administer this section. The rules must provide for standards and a
- 18 curriculum for the kindergarten-plus program.
- 19 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 20 of this Act, the commissioner shall adopt rules relating to the
- 21 kindergarten-plus program provided for by Section 29.161,
- 22 Education Code, as added by this Act.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
