- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The Texas Insurance Code is amended to read as 6 follows:
- 7 Art. 5.43-2 Fire Detection and Alarm Services.
- 8 Definitions, Sec. 2 As used in this Article:
- 9 (17) "Residential Fire Alarm Technician" means a licensed 10 individual who shall be designated by a registered firm to:
- A) plan, install, service, inspect and certify
- 12 residential single-family or two-family fire alarm or detection
- 13 systems; or
- B) perform the servicing or maintaining of a
- 15 previously installed residential single-family or two-family fire
- 16 alarm device or system and to certify such service or maintenance;

- 18 (C) provide onsite direct supervision of a
- 19 non-licensed employee of a registered firm while installing,
- 20 servicing, inspecting or maintaining residential single-family or
- 21 two-family fire alarm or detection systems. A residential fire
- 22 alarm technician may not provide direct supervision as required in
- 23 Section 3, 8 of this chapter other than on residential
- 24 single-family or two-family fire alarm or detection systems.
