## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

L	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the use of the substance pancuronium bromide to execute
- 3 an inmate sentenced to death.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 43.14, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 43.14. EXECUTION OF CONVICT. (a) Whenever the
- 8 sentence of death is pronounced against a convict, the sentence
- 9 shall be executed at any time after the hour of 6 p.m. on the day set
- 10 for the execution, by intravenous injection of a substance or
- 11 substances in a lethal quantity sufficient to cause death and until
- such convict is dead, such execution procedure to be determined and
- 13 supervised by the Director of the institutional division of the
- 14 Texas Department of Criminal Justice.
- (b) The substance pancuronium bromide may not be used to
- 16 execute a convict under this article.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 22 legislative session.
