7	Sec. 1357.052. APPLICABILITY OF SUBCHAPTER. (a) This
8	subchapter applies only to a health benefit plan that:
9	(1) provides benefits for medical or surgical expenses
10	incurred as a result of a health condition, accident, or sickness,
11	including:
12	(A) an individual, group, blanket, or franchise
13	insurance policy or insurance agreement, a group hospital service
14	contract, or an individual or group evidence of coverage that is
15	offered by:
16	(i) an insurance company;
17	(ii) a group hospital service corporation
18	operating under Chapter 842;
19	(iii) a fraternal benefit society operating

(iv) a stipulated premium company operating

(v) a health maintenance organization

under Chapter 884; or

operating under Chapter 843; and

- 1 (B) to the extent permitted by the Employee
- 2 Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (29 U.S.C. Section 1001 et
- 3 seq.), a health benefit plan that is offered by:
- 4 (i) a multiple employer welfare arrangement
- 5 as defined by Section 3 of that Act; or
- 6 (ii) another analogous benefit
- 7 arrangement;
- 8 (2) is offered by an approved nonprofit health
- 9 corporation that holds a certificate of authority under Chapter
- 10 844; or
- 11 (3) provides coverage only for a specific disease or
- 12 condition or for hospitalization.
- (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a standard health
- benefit plan provided <u>under Chapter 1507 or Article 3.80 or 20A.09N</u>
- must provide the coverage required by this subchapter.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to a health benefit plan that is delivered, issued for delivery, or
- 18 renewed on or after January 1, 2006. A health benefit plan that is
- delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2006,
- 20 is covered by the law in effect at the time the health benefit plan
- 21 was delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed, and that law is
- 22 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
