1 (c) If this chapter applies to a municipality as provided by 2 Subsection (a), the application of this chapter to the municipality is not affected if the municipality's population changes and the 3 4 municipality no longer meets the population requirement of Subsection (a)(1). 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
