## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to importing prescription drugs for use in state-funded
- 3 programs that provide health care services or benefits.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. PRESCRIPTION DRUG STUDY. (a) In this section,
- 6 "system" means the Employees Retirement System of Texas.
- 7 (b) The system shall conduct a detailed study to determine
- 8 whether importing prescription drugs from a foreign country for use
- 9 in the state employees group benefits program would be safe,
- 10 feasible, and cost-effective.
- 11 (c) The system may:
- 12 (1) enter into interagency contracts with other state
- 13 agencies to extend the study to other state-funded programs that
- 14 provide health care services or benefits; and
- 15 (2) consult with other state agencies, as appropriate.
- 16 (d) Not later than September 1, 2006, the system shall
- 17 report the results of the study, including proposed legislation
- 18 necessary to implement any recommendations contained in the report,
- 19 to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of
- 20 representatives, and appropriate standing committees of the
- 21 legislature.
- 22 SECTION 2. EXPIRATION. This Act expires December 31, 2006.
- 23 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 24 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
