7	this subchapter is superior to any other lien on the same property,
8	with the exception of a lien for ad valorem taxes. Any owner or
9	lienholder of record must be provided written notice of a wage lien
10	by certified mail or registered mail addressed to the owner or
11	lienholder's address set forth in the recorded documents, and to
12	its registered agent if one has been appointed, and an opportunity
13	of ninety (90) days thereafter to pay the wage lien or to file suit
