| 3 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 4 | SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 25, Education Code, is |
| 5 | amended by adding Section 25.902 to read as follows: |
| 6 | Sec. 25.902. CONTACT BETWEEN STUDENT WHO COMMITS ASSAULT |
| 7 | AND STUDENT VICTIM. (a) This section applies only to: |
| 8 | (1) a student who: |
| 9 | (A) has been convicted of an offense described by |
| 10 | Section 37.006(a)(2)(B) or 37.007(a)(2)(A); |
| 11 | (B) has been found by a court to have engaged in |
| 12 | delinquent conduct on the basis of conduct described by Section |
| 13 | 37.006(a)(2)(B) or 37.007(a)(2)(A); or |
| 14 | (C) has been accused of committing an offense |
| 15 | described by Section 37.006(a)(2)(B) or 37.007(a)(2)(A) or of |
| 16 | engaging in conduct that contains the elements of such an offense, |
| 17 | and has had a protective order issued against the student in |
| 18 | connection with the alleged offense or conduct; and |
| 19 | (2) a student who is the victim of conduct described by |
| 20 | Subdivision (1). |
| 21 | (b) A student who is a victim to whom Subsection (a)(2) |
| 22 | applies who is assigned to the same campus as the student who |
| 23 | committed the offense or engaged in the conduct may notify a |
| 24 | counselor at the campus, or in the student's school district if the |

- 1 campus does not have a counselor, of the offense or other conduct
- 2 and request that the counselor attempt to ensure limited contact
- 3 between the victim and the other student in the manner provided by
- 4 Subsection (c).
- 5 (c) For purposes of this subsection, "parent" includes a
- 6 person standing in parental relation. On receiving a request under
- 7 Subsection (b) from a student who is a victim, the counselor shall
- 8 suggest to the parent of the student who committed the offense or
- 9 engaged in the conduct that the parent attempt to transfer the
- 10 student to or enroll the student in another school. If the
- 11 student's parent refuses or is unable to transfer the student to or
- 12 enroll the student in another school, the counselor shall develop a
- 13 plan for ensuring that the student and the student who is the victim
- 14 have limited contact during the school day and during any
- 15 <u>extracurricular activities</u>. The counselor shall coordinate with
- 16 the parent of the student who committed the offense or engaged in
- 17 the conduct and the parent of the victim separately in developing
- 18 the plan.
- 19 (d) The counselor shall continue to serve as a resource to
- 20 both students. The counselor cannot be held responsible for either
- 21 student's violation of the plan.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2005-2006
- 23 school year.
- 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
