5	Sec. 82.782. PROHIBITED ACTS. (a) Except as provided by
6	Subsections (b) and (c), a person may not:
7	(1) operate an airboat, a jet-boat, or any
8	propeller-driven vessel in the Nine-Mile Hole State Scientific
9	Area; or
10	(2) move, remove, deface, alter, or destroy:
11	(A) an informational sign, including a depth
12	marker, placed by the department in the Nine-Mile Hole State
13	Scientific Area; or
14	(B) a boundary marker of the Nine-Mile Hole State
15	Scientific Area.
16	(b) A person in the Nine-Mile Hole State Scientific Area
17	may:
18	(1) operate a vessel propelled by an electric trolling
19	motor;
20	(2) operate an airboat, a jet-boat, or any
21	propeller-driven vessel in lanes of entrance and exit marked by the
22	department; or
23	(3) engage in an act prohibited by Subsection (a) if

1	(c) Subsection (a) does not apply to a person in an
2	emergency threatening human health and safety that necessitates
3	immediate entrance to or exit from the Nine-Mile Hole State
4	Scientific Area.
5	Sec. 82.783. PENALTY. A person who violates Section 82.782
6	commits an offense that is a Class C Parks and Wildlife Code
7	misdemeanor, except that a person who violates Section 82.782 and
8	has previously been convicted of violating that section commits an
9	offense that is a Class B Parks and Wildlife Code misdemeanor.
10	Sec. 82.784. GIFTS, GRANTS, DONATIONS, AND OTHER
11	ASSISTANCE. The department may apply for, request, solicit,
12	contract for, and accept gifts, grants, donations, or other
13	assistance from any source to implement and enforce this
14	subchapter.
15	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 2005, if it

16 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each 17 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. 18 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that 19 date, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
