13-57 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 13-58 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 13-59 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of 13-60 representatives within the required time.

13-61 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this 13-62 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect 13-63 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled 13-64 and accomplished.

13-65 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 13-66 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 13-67 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
