HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, January 2005 has been designated as the second
- 2 National Stalking Awareness Month in the United States; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The National Center for Victims of Crime initiated
- 4 this observance after the death of Peggy Klinke in January 2003; Ms.
- 5 Klinke was murdered by a former boyfriend after repeatedly seeking
- 6 law enforcement intervention and moving to another state in search
- 7 of safety; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Her tragic story is far from rare; in this country,
- 9 more than a million women and nearly 400,000 men are stalked
- 10 annually; 1 in 12 women and 1 in 45 men will be stalked in their
- 11 lifetime, and the majority of victims are stalked by someone they
- 12 know; and
- WHEREAS, Of those women who have been killed by an intimate
- 14 partner, 76 percent were stalked by that partner in the year before
- 15 their death, and 81 percent of those women who are stalked by a
- 16 current or former intimate partner are at some point physically
- 17 assaulted by that individual; and
- WHEREAS, Victims of stalking experience anxiety, insomnia,
- 19 social dysfunction, lost work hours and productivity, and severe
- 20 depression at a much higher rate than the general population; they
- 21 are also forced to take such drastic measures to protect themselves
- 22 as obtaining court orders, changing jobs, changing their
- 23 identities, and relocating; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Stalking is a crime under federal law and under the

- 1 laws of all 50 states and the District of Columbia; national
- 2 organizations, local victim services, prosecutors' offices, and
- 3 police departments are working to further develop effective
- 4 responses to this terrifying crime, which cuts across race,
- 5 culture, gender, age, and economic status; and
- 6 WHEREAS, It is vital that the public understand the
- 7 seriousness of this offense, as well as be aware of the resources
- 8 that are available to those who have been targeted by a stalker;
- 9 moreover, measures to enhance the response of the criminal justice
- 10 system to stalking and stalking victims are to be strongly
- 11 encouraged; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the 79th Legislature of the State of Texas
- 13 hereby recognize January 2005 as National Stalking Awareness Month
- 14 and commend all those who are working to combat this intolerable
- 15 aggression.
