WHEREAS, The only four brothers to serve in the Vietnam War at the same time, the Bolanos brothers were born in California and were living in Texas in the mid-1960s when they volunteered for duty in Southeast Asia; Louis went to Vietnam as a member of the Navy, Ben as a member of the Marine Corps, Bill as a member of the Army's Special Forces, also known as Green Berets, and Rick as a member of the Army Airborne; and

WHEREAS, Three of the brothers fought together in the battle for Dong Ha, the chief logistics base for American and South Vietnamese operations in the north and a command base for two Marine divisions; in late April and early May 1968, the North Vietnamese tried to drive toward Dong Ha through the eastern part of the DMZ, but were repelled in heavy fighting; and

WHEREAS, During the 2004 presidential campaign, the Bolanos brothers traveled extensively throughout the United States, encouraging veterans to vote and get involved in the political process; and

WHEREAS, Instilled with a fervent patriotism by their father, who came to the United States to start a new life, the Bolanos brothers have answered their country's call with unfaltering
