2 December 22, 2004, at the age of 81, deeply saddened the family and
3 friends of this beloved woman; and

4 WHEREAS, A native Texan, Mrs. Kemp was born May 4, 1923, in
5 Brookston; she graduated from Paris High School and went on to
6 attend Paris Training School for Registered Nurses; and

7 WHEREAS, This respected healthcare professional helped to
8 open the medical department of the Campbell's Soup Company plant in
9 Paris, ultimately retiring as manager; she was a member of the Texas
10 Nurses Association, American Nurses Association, and National
11 Industrial Nurses Association; and

12 WHEREAS, Mrs. Kemp was a highly regarded resident in her
13 community; a member of the Paris Golf and Country Club, she was the
14 first woman to serve on its board of directors; she also was a
15 member of the Ladies Golf Association; and

16 WHEREAS, She attended First United Methodist Church, where
17 she and her husband, Henry, served as counselors for the senior high
18 department; and

19 WHEREAS, Though Patsy Kemp's passing has left a void in the
20 lives of those who knew and loved her, her spirit will continue to
21 live on in the hearts of the many people whose lives she touched;
22 now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the 79th Legislature of the State of Texas
24 hereby honor the life of Patsy Brulte Kemp and extend deepest
