2 moments, and meaningful accomplishments may comfort the family and  
3 friends of Richard J. Rast of the Howland community, who passed away  
4 on July 20, 2004, at the age of 68; and

5           WHEREAS, Born on April 27, 1936, in Mexia, Dick Rast  
6 graduated from Olney schools, attended Paris Junior College, where  
7 he played football, and received his undergraduate degree from  
8 Texas Western University; after serving with distinction in the  
9 U.S. Marine Corps, he entered Midwestern University and earned his  
10 master's degree in biology from East Texas State University; and

11           WHEREAS, A gifted teacher and coach known as "Bear," he began  
12 his education career on the Tyonek Indian Reservation in Alaska;  
13 when he returned to Texas, he taught at Cunningham, Deport,  
14 Prairiland, and Chisum and implemented the football programs at  
15 Prairiland and Chisum schools; and

16           WHEREAS, An avid outdoorsman and master gunsmith, he loved  
17 hunting and had an impressive knowledge of nature and animals,  
18 which he happily shared with his nephews and grandchildren; and

19           WHEREAS, Those fortunate enough to have known this notable  
20 man will remember him always, and their lives have been enriched by  
21 his friendship and love; now, therefore, be it

22           RESOLVED, That the 79th Legislature of the State of Texas  
23 hereby pay tribute to the life of Richard J. Rast and extend sincere  
24 sympathy to the members of his family: to his sons and their wives:
