

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, House Bill No. 2110 has been adopted by the house of
2 representatives and the senate; and

3 WHEREAS, The bill contains technical errors that should be
4 corrected; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED by the 79th Legislature of the State of Texas, That
6 the enrolling clerk of the house of representatives be instructed
7 to correct House Bill No. 2110 in the SECTION of the bill that adds
8 Section 30.05(h), Penal Code, by striking "has the meaning assigned
9 by Section 46.15" and substituting the following:

10 "means another state with which the attorney general of this state,
11 with the approval of the governor of this state, negotiated an
12 agreement after determining that the other state:

13 (1) has firearm proficiency requirements for peace
14 officers; and

15 (2) fully recognizes the right of peace officers
16 commissioned in this state to carry weapons in the other state".
