(a) 4 The 5 department shall include in a draft or final environmental impact 6 statement prepared as part of the environmental review of a 7 Trans-Texas Corridor project information detailing: 8 (1) the reasons for the immediate and future needs of the project; 9 10 (2) the reasonableness of and necessity for the 11 project; and 12 (3) after a segment of the project has advanced: (A) the reasons for the immediate and future 13 14 needs for each mode of transportation in that segment of the 15 project; and (B) the reasonableness and necessity for each 16 17 mode of transportation in that segment of the project. (b) After receiving approval from the federal government, 18 19 the department shall: (1) post the final environmental impact statement on 20 21 the department's Internet website, along with information concerning where a copy of the environmental impact statement may 22 be reviewed or obtained; and 23 (2) provide notice to each state senator and 24 representative who represents all or part of the area in which a 25 26 segment of the project is located, and the commissioners court of each county in which a segment of the project is located, that the 27
