## A JOINT RESOLUTION

proposing a constitutional amendment providing that political
subdivisions are exempt from unfunded legislative mandates.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by 5 adding Section 67 to read as follows:

6 <u>Sec. 67. (a) In this section, "legislative mandate" means</u> 7 <u>a statutory provision enacted by the legislature that requires a</u> 8 <u>political subdivision to establish, expand, or modify an activity</u> 9 <u>in a way that requires an expenditure of revenue that would not have</u> 10 <u>been required in the absence of the provision.</u>

11 (b) For purposes of this section, a legislative mandate is 12 considered to be unfunded during any period for which the 13 legislature has not appropriated or otherwise provided funds, other 14 than revenue of the political subdivision, estimated to be 15 sufficient to meet the cost of financing the expenditure, as 16 determined by law.

17 (c) A political subdivision is exempt from a legislative 18 mandate during a period in which the mandate is unfunded. The 19 legislature by general law shall authorize a state officer or state 20 agency, which may include members of the legislature, to identify 21 legislative mandates and determine whether a legislative mandate is 22 considered unfunded for a specific period.

- 23 (d) This section does not apply to:
- 24 (1) a legislative mandate enacted before January 1,

2	(2) a legislative mandate that is necessary to comply
3	with a requirement of the Texas Constitution, federal law, or a
4	court order; or
5	(3) a legislative mandate that creates a criminal
6	offense or changes the elements of a criminal offense.
7	SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
8	submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2005.
9	The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
10	proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing that
11	political subdivisions are exempt from unfunded legislative
12	mandates."
