A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to require a house or

- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 12, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 12. <u>(a)</u> Each House shall keep a journal of its
- 8 proceedings, and publish the same.
- 9 (b) A vote taken by either House or by a committee of either
- 10 House must be by record vote entered in the journal of the House or
- in the committee minutes, as appropriate, if the vote is on approval
- or disapproval of a bill, a measure proposing or ratifying a
- constitutional amendment, an amendment or substitute to such a bill
- or measure, the appointment or election of a legislative officer or
- 15 other public official, or the confirmation of an appointment to
- 16 public office; and the yeas and nays of the members of either House
- on any other question shall, at the desire of any three members
- 18 present, be entered on the journals.
- (c) Each House shall establish procedures to make each
- 20 record vote required by Subsection (b) of this section available to
- 21 the public through the Internet or a successor electronic
- communications system accessible by the general public by reference
- 23 to the name or number of the bill, resolution, or other measure or,
- 24 <u>if applicable, by reference to the name of the person whose</u>

- 1 appointment, election, or confirmation is being considered. The
- 2 procedures must require the record of the vote to be made accessible
- 3 within a reasonable time after the vote is taken.

4 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2005. 5 6 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the proposition: "The constitutional amendment to require that a record 7 8 vote be taken by a house or committee of the legislature on any bill, constitutional amendment, amendment to a bill 9 constitutional amendment, election or appointment of a public 10 official, or confirmation of an appointment to public office, and 11

to provide for public access on the Internet to those record votes."
