## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to allocate an amount greater than one-fourth of the net revenue
- 3 from the tax on motor fuels sold to volunteer fire departments to
- 4 the available school fund.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 7-c to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 7-c. Notwithstanding Section 7-a of this article, the
- 9 legislature may allocate an amount greater than one-fourth of the
- 10 net revenue from the tax on motor fuels sold to volunteer fire
- 11 departments for their exclusive use to the Available School Fund.
- 12 If the legislature allocates less than the entire amount of net
- 13 revenue to the Available School Fund, the legislature shall
- 14 allocate the remaining net revenue for the purposes relating to
- 15 public roadways described in Section 7-a of this article.
- 16 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2005.
- 18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 20 legislature to allocate an amount greater than one-fourth of the
- 21 net revenue from the tax on motor fuels sold to volunteer fire
- 22 departments to the available school fund."
