A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing casino gaming.
- 2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 3 SECTION 1. Section 47, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 4 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (f) to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (a) The Legislature shall pass laws prohibiting lotteries
- 7 and gift enterprises in this State other than those authorized by
- 8 Subsections (b), (d), [and] (e), and (f) of this section.
 - (f) The Legislature by general law may:
- 10 (1) authorize and regulate casino gaming conducted by
- 11 the holder of a license or permit issued by the State for that
- 12 purpose; and

- 13 (2) limit the locations at which casino gaming may be
- 14 conducted to territory in which a majority of qualified voters
- 15 voting on the question vote to permit casino gaming.
- 16 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2005.
- 18 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to authorize casino
- 20 gaming in Texas and to permit the legislature to limit casino gaming
- 21 to areas that approve casino gaming by local option election."
