- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article I, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 11b to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 11b. VIOLATION OF CONDITION OF RELEASE PENDING TRIAL;
- 8 DENIAL OF BAIL. Any person accused of a felony in this state who is
- 9 released on bail pending trial and whose bail is subsequently
- 10 revoked or forfeited for a violation of a condition of release may
- 11 be denied bail pending trial on a determination by a district judge
- in this state, at a subsequent hearing to set or reinstate bail,
- 13 that the person violated a condition of release related to the
- 14 safety of a victim of the alleged offense or to the safety of the
- 15 community.
- 16 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 17 submitted to the voters at an election to be held on November 8,
- 18 2005. The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or
- 19 against the proposition: "The constitutional amendment
- 20 authorizing the denial of bail to a criminal defendant who violates
- 21 a condition of the defendant's release pending trial."
