## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to remove restrictions on the
- 2 types of voting methods that may be used to elect the governing body
- 3 of a municipality.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11(b), Article XI, Texas Constitution,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A municipality so providing a term exceeding two (2)
- 8 years but not exceeding four (4) years for any of its non-civil
- 9 service officers must fill [elect all of the members of its
- 10 governing body by majority vote of the qualified voters in such
- 11 municipality, and any vacancy or vacancies occurring on the [such]
- 12 governing body of the municipality [shall not be filled by
- 13 appointment but must be filled] by [majority] vote of the qualified
- 14 voters at a special election called for such purpose within one
- 15 hundred and twenty (120) days after such vacancy or vacancies
- 16 occur.
- 17 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2005.
- 19 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 20 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to remove restrictions
- 21 on the types of voting methods that may be used to elect the
- 22 governing body of a municipality."
