## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to exempt the residence homesteads of certain totally disabled
- 3 veterans from ad valorem taxation.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1-b, Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- is amended by adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:
- 7 (i) The legislature by general law may exempt all or part of
- 8 the market value of the residence homestead of a disabled veteran of
- 9 the armed services of the United States who is permanently and
- 10 totally disabled as a result of a service-connected disability from
- 11 ad valorem taxation and may provide eligibility requirements for
- 12 the exemption.
- 13 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2005.
- 15 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 16 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 17 legislature to exempt the residence homesteads of certain totally
- 18 disabled veterans from ad valorem taxation."
