## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment relating to the recall of
- 2 school trustees.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 11, Texas Education Code is amended by
- 5 inserting Subchapter D to read as follows and relettering the
- 6 existing Subchapter D and subsequent chapters:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER D. RECALL OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES
- 8 Sec. 11.065. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
- 9 (1) "Recall election" means an election conducted
- 10 under this subchapter.
- 11 (2) "Trustee" means a member of the board of trustees
- of a school district elected under this chapter.
- Sec. 11.066. ORDERING ELECTION. Except as otherwise
- 14 provided by this subchapter, a board of trustees shall order a
- 15 recall election as to a trustee if the board is presented with a
- 16 petition that meets the requirements of Section 11.067 and is
- 17 certified as valid under Section 11.068.
- Sec. 11.067. PETITION. (a) A petition for a recall
- 19 election must have a statement substantially as follows preceding
- 20 the space reserved for signatures on each page: "This petition is
- 21 to require that an election be held in (name of school district) on
- the recall of trustee (name of trustee)."
- 23 (b) A petition may not name more than one trustee.
- (c) A petition is valid only if it is signed by registered

- 1 voters residing in the school district in a number equal to or
- 2 greater than 10 percent of the number of votes cast in the most
- 3 recent general election for trustees in the district.
- 4 (d) Each voter must enter beside the voter's signature the
- 5 date the voter signs the petition. A signature may not be counted
- 6 if the date of signing is earlier than:
- 7 (1) the 180th day after the date the trustee's current
- 8 term began; or
- 9 (2) the 90th day before the date the petition is
- 10 <u>submitted to the board of trustees.</u>
- 11 (e) Each voter must provide the voter's current voter
- 12 registration number, printed name, and residence address,
- 13 including zip code.
- 14 Sec. 11.068. VERIFICATION OF PETITION. (a) Not later than
- 15 the fifth day after the date a petition for a recall election is
- 16 <u>received in the office of the board of trustees, the board shall</u>
- 17 submit the petition for verification to the secretary of the board.
- 18 If the petition is to require an election on the recall of the
- 19 trustee who serves as secretary, the board shall appoint an acting
- 20 secretary to perform the secretary's duties under this section.
- 21 (b) The secretary shall determine whether the petition is
- 22 signed by the required number of registered voters of the school
- 23 <u>district</u>. Not later than the 30th day after the date the petition
- 24 is submitted to the secretary, the secretary shall certify in
- 25 writing to the board of trustees whether the petition is valid or
- 26 invalid. If the secretary determines the petition is invalid, the
- 27 secretary shall state each reason for that determination.

- Sec. 11.069. DATE OF ELECTION; ORDER. (a) If the secretary
- 2 certifies that a petition is valid, the board of trustees shall
- 3 order that an election be held in the school district on the first
- 4 Saturday after the 45th day after the date the board orders the
- 5 election.
- 6 (b) If the date prescribed by Subsection (a) is less than 60
- 7 days before the expiration of the term of the trustee to whom the
- 8 petition relates, the board may not order the election.
- 9 (c) The board shall state in the order the issue to be voted
- 10 <u>on.</u>
- Sec. 11.070. BALLOT PROPOSITION. The ballot in a recall
- 12 election shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 13 proposition: "Recalling trustee (name of trustee)."
- Sec. 11.071. RESULTS OF ELECTION. If the majority of the
- 15 votes received in a recall election are for the recall of the
- trustee, the office held by the trustee becomes vacant effective
- immediately on the canvassing of the votes. The vacancy shall be
- 18 filled in the regular manner.
- 19 Sec. 11.072. MULTIPLE RECALL ATTEMPTS PROHIBITED. The
- 20 board of trustees may not order a recall election as to a trustee
- 21 who has been the subject of a previous recall election during the
- 22 <u>trustee's current term.</u>
