## A JOINT RESOLUTION

proposing a constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature to allow the governing body of a political subdivision to provide an additional exemption from ad valorem taxation for property owned by certain disabled veterans who have been awarded the Purple Heart or the Congressional Medal of Honor or their surviving spouses.

- BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
  SECTION 1. Section 2, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is
- 8 amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

9 (b-1) In addition to the exemption provided by Subsection (b) of this section, for a disabled veteran as defined by Subsection 10 11 (b) of this section who has a service-connected disability rating 12 of more than 70 percent and has been awarded the Purple Heart or the Congressional Medal of Honor, the Legislature, by general law, may 13 14 authorize the governing body of a county, city, town, school district, or other political subdivision of this state, in the 15 16 manner required by law for official action, to provide an exemption from taxation by the political subdivision of not more than \$25,000 17 18 of the assessed value of a property that is provided an exemption under Subsection (b) of this section. The Legislature may 19 authorize the governing body of a taxing unit that grants an 20 21 exemption to a disabled veteran under this subsection to provide for the transfer of the exemption for the property to the surviving 22 23 spouse of the disabled veteran.
