1 WHEREAS, The Richardson Republican Women's Club has long been
2 an integral part of its North Texas community, and it is most
3 appropriate to honor this distinguished group of citizens for their
4 many noteworthy accomplishments; and

5 WHEREAS, The Richardson Republican Women's Club was founded
6 in 1958, and its members have worked through the years for better
7 government and for the betterment of their community, giving
8 generously of their time and diverse talents to a host of worthy
9 initiatives; these dedicated individuals regularly participate in
10 outreach and literacy programs and have provided financial support
11 to the public libraries of Texas for more than four decades; and

12 WHEREAS, The club has received the Dallas County Council of
13 Republican Women Executive Committee's Certificate of
14 Appreciation, the Texas Federation of Republican Women's
15 Certificate of Merit, the Participation, Activity, and Teamwork
16 (PAT) Award, the John Goodwin Tower Award of Excellence, and many
17 others; several of the members have also been given such special
18 recognition as the Volunteer of the Year for Texas and
19 commendations from the Dallas County Republican Party; and

20 WHEREAS, Last year the Richardson Republican Women's Club
21 lost one of its most devoted and esteemed members, Virginia
22 Steenson, who died on February 14, 2004; Ms. Steenson was a charter
23 member of the RRW, an extremely active community volunteer, and a
24 former member of the SREC; and

1 WHEREAS, The year 2004 also included many happy events for
2 the Richardson Republican Women's Club; it was honored to have a
3 record number of members participate in the convention process at
4 the precinct, senatorial, and state levels, and two members were
5 national delegates at the convention in New York City; and

7 can take great pride in their myriad accomplishments as well as in
8 their enduring contributions to the Lone Star State; now,
9 therefore, be it
