## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The city of Laredo is celebrating the life of one of 2 this nation's most revered leaders when it hosts the 108th 3 Washington's Birthday Celebration from January 29 to February 20, 4 2005; and

5 WHEREAS, Born in Virginia on February 22, 1732, President 6 George Washington left an indelible legacy as this nation's first 7 commander in chief and president; admired for his courage, vision, 8 and integrity, he remains one of the most influential and respected 9 United States presidents of all time; and

WHEREAS, The special Laredo celebration of Washington's 10 birthday dates back to February 22, 1898, when the tribe of the 11 12 Improved Order of Red Men, a patriotic fraternal organization 13 descended from the Sons of Liberty, and the defenders of City Hall 14 staged a spirited mock battle, representing the colonial struggle against the British; when the Red Men emerged victorious and the 15 mayor presented the key to the City of Laredo to the "Great Chief 16 Sachem," "Sachem" being a code name used by George Washington 17 18 during the American Revolution, a tradition was born; and

WHEREAS, This 17-day, 32-event extravaganza combines elements of both Hispanic and Anglo cultures and features parades, pageants, and concerts, as well as a carnival, a children's fun fest, fireworks, and an abundance of good food; the largest of its kind in the United States, this annual celebration continues to grow, attracting thousands of visitors each year; and
